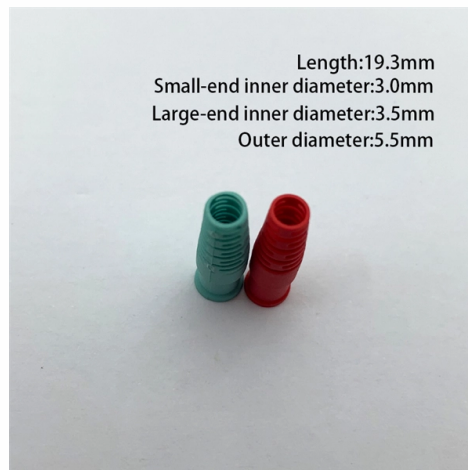


Vertical Installation of Grid Cable Trays

Bend Radius: Respect the minimum bend radius for cables as they enter or exit vertical trays to prevent conductor damage ().
