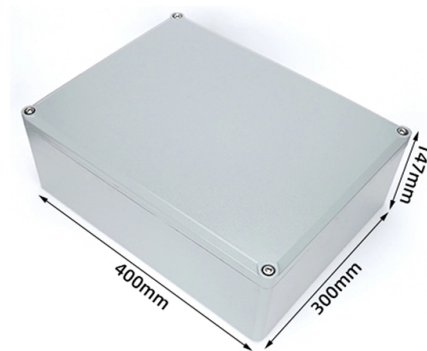


Vertical installation of cable trays on walls



AI Overview

Vertical cable trays on walls require proper material selection, secure support systems, correct spacing, and adherence to electrical codes to ensure safety and reliability.

Material and Design Considerations Vertical cable trays must be made from materials that provide mechanical strength and corrosion resistance, such as cold-rolled steel, galvanized steel, or aluminum alloy, with surface treatments like hot-dip galvanizing or electrostatic spraying to meet anti-corrosion standards (GB/T 13912) and fire resistance (GB 8624 Class B1). The tray system typically includes the tray, cover, and connectors, with a load-bearing capacity of at least 200 kg/m. Design should avoid interference with ventilation ducts, water pipes, and maintain a minimum clearance of 300 mm from other structures.

Support Methods The support system is critical for vertical installations. Common methods include cantilever wall brackets or vertical hangers, which must be securely anchored to the wall to bear the full cable load. Supports should be installed according to the manufacturer's load capacity charts, ensuring the tray is level and stable. For ladder-type trays, cross members and tray clips must be properly aligned, with sufficient horizontal adjustment to accommodate cable routing.

Spacing and Separation Tray spacing: When multiple trays are installed in layers, maintain at least 150 mm between power and weak-current trays, using isolation plates at crossings.

Fire compartments: Reserve firestop space and use certified firestop materials (GB 23864) when trays pass through fire-rated walls.

Cable fill limits: Do not exceed 40% of the tray cross-sectional area for power cables and 50% for control cables to prevent overheating.

Installation Steps Mark the wall for bracket or hanger placement, ensuring vertical alignment. Install wall brackets or cantilever supports securely, using anchors suitable for the wall material.
