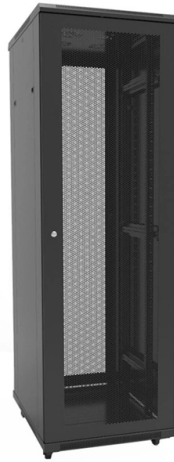

- Material:** Copper for high conductivity and corrosion resistance, aluminum for lightweight and cost efficiency.
- Cross-Sectional Area:** Determines current-carrying capacity; larger areas reduce resistance and voltage drop.
- Thermal Limits:** IEC 61439 specifies maximum operating temperatures (e.g., 140°C for low-voltage busbars) and diversity factors to calculate safe load currents.
