Splice Protection Sleeves and Holders Fusion protection sleeves and splicing protection holders safeguard the delicate splice joint from mechanical stress and environmental factors. Heat-shrinkable sleeves are commonly used to encase the splice, ensuring air-tight protection and maintaining fiber strength. The sleeve diameter and length are selected based on the application, whether in compact trays or larger enclosures.

Adapters and Connectors LC and SC adapters are widely used to connect different fiber types and maintain low attenuation and reflective losses. High-density systems allow up to 96 ports in 1U, doubling the capacity of traditional SC adapters. Proper adapter selection is critical for signal integrity and network performance.

Splicing Tools Key tools for splicing include:

- Fusion splicers:** Align and fuse fiber ends with precision, ensuring minimal splice loss.
- Cleavers:** Produce a clean, flat 90° fiber end face, essential for high-quality splices.
- Mechanical splices:** Provide a quick, cost-effective alternative to fusion splicing using V-groove or similar technologies.
