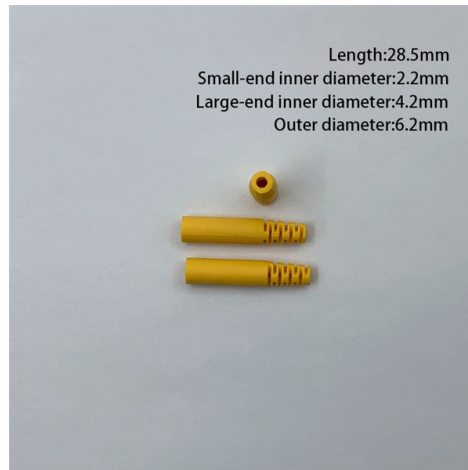


What does ATSE mean in a distribution box

Multiple utility services may be used as an emergency or standby source of power. Figure 1 shows automatic transfer between two low-voltage utility supplies. Designed for applications where total system coordination must be accomplished, they offer integral overcurrent protection with an electronic trip unit for a variety of standby power.
