EEPROM is a type of non-volatile memory, meaning it retains stored information even when the power is turned off. It allows data to be written, erased, and rewritten electrically. It communicates with host devices such as switches, routers, and firewalls through standard serial communication bus protocols, most commonly I²C. This failure prevents the host switch from authenticating the transceiver, leading to "Optic Fault" or "Unrecognized Transceiver" errors.
