

What is a low-voltage distribution box

The enclosure itself is usually made of metal or durable plastic, providing protection against environmental factors, dust, moisture, and accidental impacts ().

Functionality Low-voltage distribution boxes allow circuits to be manually or automatically switched on and off. During faults, protective devices can cut off power or trigger alarms, preventing damage to equipment and reducing the risk of fire or electric shock (). They also facilitate maintenance and management of electrical systems by centralizing control and monitoring ().

Applications These boxes are widely used in:

- Residential buildings for room or appliance-level power distribution.
- Commercial and industrial facilities for lighting, HVAC, and machinery circuits.
- Data centers and IT systems to ensure stable power supply to sensitive equipment.
- Renewable energy systems like solar or wind installations to integrate and manage low-voltage power ().
