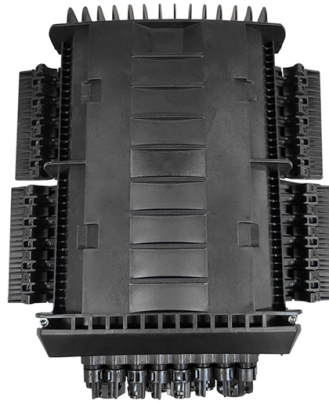


What is the material of the pigtail skin
