- Main distribution box to site: 35mm² to 50mm² 3-phase armored cable
- Sub-distribution to tool areas: 16mm² to 25mm² flexible rubber cable
- Extension to portable equipment: 2.5mm² to 6mm² flexible cable, depending on load and distance
