

What size wire should the electrical panel at the entrance have



Overview

The wire size depends on the total amperage of the service. Use wire types like SEU, SER, or USE-2, which are rated for UV resistance and moisture. Clearance: Electrical panels must be installed in a readily accessible area with a minimum clearance of 30 inches (762 mm) wide, 3 ft (36 inches or 914 mm) deep, and 6. Service-entrance conductors for the service disconnect and main panel, as well as feeder cables for subpanels, must be properly sized in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC). Correctly sized service conductors in electrical wiring installations ensure system efficiency and protection. A 100A circuit requires #3 AWG copper or #1 AWG aluminum for a subpanel feeder, or #2/0 AWG aluminum for a 100A service entrance — the most common choice in residential construction. This guide covers NEC requirements for 100 amp, 200 amp, and 400 amp services including conductor sizing, grounding, and installation considerations. The service entrance is the most critical. The wire between the meter and the main panel—often referred to as the “service entrance cable”—carries electricity from the utility meter socket into the home or building’s breaker box. It must be able to withstand environmental exposure and carry high current safely.

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Service entrance conductors (wires that bring electricity from the utility) must be appropriately sized and installed to meet load demands and NEC requirements.

NEC 310.12 Table: Wire Sizes For 100-400 Amp Services (83% Rule)

According to the 83% NEC rule, a wire for 100 amp service has to handle at least 83 amps (have at least an 83A ampacity). That means that we don't have to use the 4 AWG wire; we can use the 3 AWG

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
