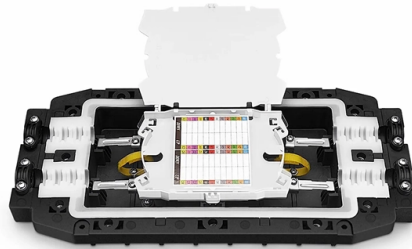


Where should the cables be connected to the distribution box

5. **Neutral and Earth Connections:** Connect the neutral wires from the loads to the neutral link inside the distribution box. Connect all earth wires, including the metallic body of the box if applicable, to the earth link. Ensure the grounding wire has sufficient cross-sectional area and is connected to the grounding network.
6. **Wire Management:** Arrange wires neatly, using plastic ties if necessary, and follow the standard color coding (phase, neutral, earth). Wiring between the main breaker and branch breakers generally goes on the left, and outgoing wires from the box go on the right.
7. **Verification:** After all connections, use a multimeter to check for proper voltage, continuity, and absence of short circuits. Ensure all screws are tightened and no exposed wires are left uninsulated.
8. **Final Safety Check:** Inspect the distribution box for any signs of damage, loose connections, or improper insulation before turning the power back on.
