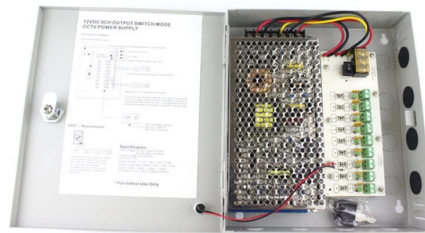

Use the standard Visio connector tool or any connector from the connectors stencils to join the shapes. Some shapes have a right-click menu e.g. many of the switches symbols have a menu to select

Push buttons, relay contacts and switches have an action on their right-click menu to swap between open and closed contacts (and the switch moves - you can use this to animate the switches). All
