

Wiring Units 201 and 110



AI Overview

Units 201 and 110 refer to electrical protection and measurement devices, including DS201 RCBOs and GE ITI 110-201 current transformers, with specific wiring and installation requirements for safe operation.

DS201 Wiring and Installation The DS201 series from ABB is a 1P+N RCBO designed for single-phase circuits, providing protection against overload, short-circuit, and earth fault currents, with additional protection against direct contact (30 mA sensitivity) for end-user safety. It operates at a minimum test voltage of 110V and is suitable for small equipment installations where external dimensions do not exceed 50 cm. When wiring a DS201 unit: Ensure the line (hot) and neutral conductors are connected to the correct terminals. Follow the manufacturer's instructions and NEC guidelines for conductor sizing and installation. Verify that the voltage rating matches the system voltage to prevent equipment damage or hazards.

GE ITI 110-201 Current Transformer Wiring The GE ITI 110-201 is an indoor, window-type current transformer (CT) used for metering and relay applications in panel boards, control panels, and engine generators. Key wiring considerations include: Connect the primary conductor through the CT window. Use the secondary terminals to connect to ammeters or protective relays. Ensure proper burden and accuracy class compliance (Metering Class 0.6, Relay Class C10). Follow UL and CSA approvals and IEEE C57.13 standards for safe operation. Maintain insulation levels of 600V, 10 kV BIL and frequency compatibility (50–400 Hz).

110V Circuit Wiring Basics For standard 110V circuits, proper plug and outlet wiring is essential: Hot wire (black) → brass terminal Neutral wire (white) → silver terminal Ground wire (green or bare copper) → green terminal Always turn off power at the breaker before wiring. Strip insulation carefully (~1/2 inch) and secure connections to prevent loose contacts. Test the circuit after wiring to ensure proper operation.
