

Wiring method for sockets in the distribution box



AI Overview

Distribution box sockets should be wired by connecting phase, neutral, and earth wires from the appropriate MCBs in the distribution box, using proper conduits, color coding, and protective devices.

General Wiring Principles

Power Supply Connection: Connect the incoming phase and neutral wires from the main supply to the input terminals of the main MCB in the distribution box. For single-phase setups, a double-pole MCB is typically used as the main switch, while single-pole MCBs are used for individual socket circuits.

Connect the earth wire to the earth link in the distribution box and then to the E terminal on the socket.

Three-phase sockets: Connect the three phase wires (L1, L2, L3) from the output of a 3- or 4-pole MCB to the corresponding terminals on the socket. Neutral and earth connections follow the same principle as single-phase sockets.

Conduits and Cable Management: Use PVC or GI conduits to route wires from the distribution box to the sockets. Conduits can be embedded in walls or mounted externally. Ensure wires are neatly bound with plastic ties and properly color-coded for phase, neutral, and earth.

Safety and Inspection: Before powering on, verify all connections, check for short circuits, and ensure proper insulation. Label all circuits clearly, and perform a multimeter test to confirm correct wiring.
